## Horsetooth 447.275:

I have a proposal out to the board to add a pre-amplifier to this repeater. As I've been listening to it a lot monitoring for interference, it's clear it could benefit from this rather inexpensive upgrade.

Budweiser Event Center repeater: The PC and WIRES-X interface have been retrieved from the event center. I have completed the configuration of the WIRES-X node with the FTM-100D mobile radio the club purchased at the recommendation of Yaesu for easing the WIRES-X setup. Everything is working properly except the software will not connect with any other "rooms". I've been working actively with Juan Hernandez at Yaesu to resolve. We had to take a brief break from working on it as he is traveling to Dayton for the hamfest. We will resume next week and install this setup as soon as we have it working.

### 224.520 repeater:

Remains on Namaqua hill in Loveland. I've requested any reports of it's performance to make sure it's audio problems have been resolved. I've received 1 total report. Long term goal is still to move this repeater to the new site (Rattlesnake Ranch).

#### 224.840 repeater:

Still needs antenna work. Hoping to get that done in the coming week. Weather and malicious interference chasing as well as travel for work have kept this from happening but that should all be behind me now and this is top priority again.

Work continues on planning for the new site. Hope to have more traction on that soon.
